PATAGONIA ~ RIO NEGRO

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The second project, Chacra in Patagonia, was founded by Nicolo Incisa's nephew Piero. It has very old ungrafted Pinot Noir vines as a trump card. Pinot Noir Trenta y Dos 2007 comes from a rare plot planted in 1932. This wine is outside the expected paradigm of Pinot Noir flavours, with its meaty, deep and intriguing character. Frankly, Trenta y Dos can take you aback if you are not prepared for it. Before settling in Bolgheri, Mario Incisa Rocchetta lived in Piedmont and made his first wine experiments with Pinot Noir. After 80 years the family history is repeating itself — now, isn't that a weird thought.
