CHACRA 55 PINOT NOIR 2011 - 91 POINTS

A South African with Danish heritage making wine in Patagonia, this is bound to be different to your usual wine here, and it is. With an incredible minerality that makes you feel like you are licking a wet stone, this is a delicate and beautiful wine that has elevated Chacra to cult status.

CHACRA MAINQUÉ MERLOT 2011 - 87 POINTS

A very cool project making wines from gnarly old vines in Patagonia, Chacra makes biodynamic and organic wines and this Merlot is stunning. Elegant, subtle and with lots of fruit, this a gorgeous wine which proves the Merlot is completely underrated in Argentina.
