**91 Bodega Chacra Pinot Noir Río Negro Treinta y Dos 2007 \$120** Juicy, with very inviting crushed plum and cherry notes layered with sweet spice, red licorice, violet and graphite. The long, racy finish is elegant but has nice latent depth. Drink now through 2012. 620 cases made.—J.M.

**90 Bodega Chacra Pinot Noir Río Negro Cincuenta y Cinco 2007 \$100** Very perfumy up front, with lilting rose petal, crushed cherry and sandalwood aromas that lead the way for supple, stylish cherry and red currant fruit. Puts on weight through the finish, with a nice lingering hint of plum sauce. Drink now through 2013. 774 cases made.—J.M.

**87 Bodega Chacra Pinot Noir Río Negro Barda 2007 \$29** Supple and inviting, with rose petal, cherry, strawberry and sweet spice notes that mingle on a fresh, modestly structured frame. Tender, but lengthy on the finish. Drink now. 2,280 cases made.—J.M.
